

CHROMEBOOK & TEXTBOOK RETURN: Chromebooks and textbooks may be returned in the office through June 6. After that date, a fee will be assessed for all missing Chromebooks and textbooks. WHAT'S HAPPENING?

REPORT CARDS AND DIPLOMAS: We plan to have report cards ready by June 7. Graduation packets for seniors, including their signed diploma and an unofficial copy of their transcript, will be available for pick up in the office starting on June 17.

COMPUTER SKILLS TEST: Illiana offers an optional Computer Skills Test for incoming freshmen and transfer students. If you have an incoming freshman or transfer student, and would like to sign up for the test use the online form linked <u>here</u>. Attached is a document listing what is included on the test.

NWEA MAP TEST: Illiana Christian High School will administer the NWEA-MAP Test to students that do not have access to standardized testing at their own school or are homeschooled, and who have enrolled for admission to Illiana for the 2024 - 2025 school year. This is required of students who do not have test scores. If your student attended Crown Point Christian, Highland Christian, or Lansing Christian, they will have test scores that have been sent to Illiana. FROM THE COUNSELING OFFICE:

- **FINAL ILLIANA TRANSCRIPT:** Students are responsible for sending their final, official transcript to their future college, trade school, military recruiter, or employer. - **IVY TECH TRANSCRIPT:** Students planning to transfer the dual credit they earned through Ivy Tech Community College to their future college or trade school should go to <u>order Ivy Tech transcript</u> on **JUNE 14th** or later. Contact Ivy Tech with any questions.

HEALTH RECORDS:

- The Indiana State Department of Health requires that all incoming **seniors** receive a 2nd MCV4 (Meningococcal A) vaccine. Please mail, email or drop off an updated immunization record **BEFORE** school starts in August. You may email records to shoffman@illianachristian.org. Please send a scanned copy, not a photo of the records. Or, you may drop off or mail a copy.
- Parents of incoming **freshmen and transfer students**, please make sure your student's immunizations are up-to-date. Do not rely on records from your previous school. Also, students from Illinois must have their Hepatitis B shots as is required in Indiana. You may email records to shoffman@illianachristian.org. Please send a scanned copy, not a photo of the records. Or, you may drop off or mail a copy.
- Any family that has filled out a Religious Objection Form for vaccinations must complete a new form **EVERY YEAR**. Please send an updated form, for the 2024 -2025 school year, to the office before the school year starts. You may email updated forms to shoffman@illianachristian.org, or bring them to the office.
