COUNSELING OFFICE NEWS

- College Financial Aid Night: Juniors, seniors and their parents/guardians are encouraged to attend this meeting in the Commons which will be on October 14, from 7:00-9:00 p.m. Important information will be given regarding the FAFSA and general scholarship information. Indiana now requires ALL SENIORS to complete the FAFSA regardless of whether they plan to attend college or not. This informational night will be helpful in understanding how to complete the FAFSA.
- **PSAT:** <u>ALL JUNIORS</u> will be taking the PSAT-NMSQT on October 16. Indiana requires ALL juniors to take the SAT test in the spring. The PSAT will continue to be the National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test, but it will also serve as a practice test for the SAT. <u>Coaching dates are September 17th, 19th, and 26th, from 7:00-9:00 p.m. The fee for coaching is \$70</u>. There is no fee to take the test itself. Students may sign up for the <u>COACHING</u> in the office with Mrs. West beginning September 3rd. - SCRIP: All monthly orders go out on the first Tuesday of the month. All orders are due online by 8:00 am. If you are paying by check for the monthly order all checks must be in the office by 8:00 am on the first Tuesday of each month. Reminder that checks are only accepted for physical gift cards ordered through the monthly orders. Any ScripNow, Reload, or ReloadNow cards must be paid online with a bank account.

SPORTS NEWS

- **Trainer Fee:** The \$50 trainer fee for fall sports will be added to your tuition account sometime this month. This is a per-student/per-sport fee for all athletes.
- Admission prices for all indoor and outdoor athletic events (excluding tennis): Adults: \$7, Students (with ID): \$5, Seniors: \$5.00, and the Fall Family Pass: \$40. The Family Pass covers Soccer and Volleyball.

TUITION OFFICE NEWS

- Foundation Fund Earnings: The Foundation Fund offers an *estimated* yearly tuition credit of \$200 available to all students. All funds that are NOT claimed by October 31, 2024 will automatically be given to the Tuition Assistance Fund of the school. The Tuition Assistance Fund is used throughout the year to help families in need who are struggling to pay tuition. If you would like to donate your credit to the Tuition Assistance Fund, you do not need to do anything. If you would like to accept the credit, please fill out the Foundation Fund Earnings form.
- **Tuition Payments:** All families should be receiving automated emails from FACTS containing tuition invoices and payment notifications. If you are NOT receiving emails and/or have not made a payment yet this year, please contact Kathy West ASAP at kwest@illianachristian.org or 219-558-7066 x111.
- **Incidental Billing:** Incidental Fees such as Bus Fees, Sports Fees, etc. are billed separately from tuition. You will only receive an Incidental Invoice via email if charges have been added to your account and payment is due. **PLEASE** take note whether or not you are signed up for Auto Pay on these invoices. If you are **not** signed up for Auto Pay, you must pay these invoices **on time**. Payment can be made online through your Family Portal or by check/cash in the office.
