Important information will be given regarding the FAFSA and general scholarship information. <u>Indiana now requires ALL SENIORS to complete the FAFSA regardless of whether they plan to attend college or not.</u> This informational night will be helpful in understanding how to complete the FAFSA.
- PSAT: All Juniors will be taking the PSAT on October 16. Indiana requires ALL juniors to take
  the SAT test in the spring. The PSAT will continue to be the National Merit Scholarship
  Qualifying Test, but it will also serve as a practice test for the required SAT. Students must
  bring their FULLY CHARGED Chromebooks and a calculator on the day of the test. Any
